This term our unit of work is **Ecco la mia famiglia** (Here is my family). Our story is **II Pappagallo e`scappato** (The parrot has escaped)

Students will:

- Write a Mother's day card in Italian using the language structure of a greeting card
- Respond to classroom routines and instructions using gestures, movement and modelled language
- Name family members and give descriptive information
- Recognise and reproduce Italian letters and sounds

Physical Education with Joe

The Physical Education program delivers 1 lesson a week for each Year 1 class.

In term 2 the PE program will continue to work on fundamental movement skills **(FMS)** and **ball control** in particular with a major focus on **kicking skills** whilst demonstrating turn-taking and sharing of equipment.

Students will also be exploring and identifying the positive feelings they experience when participating in physical activity.

At the start of Term 2 our Year 1 students will also be participating in our annual **Sports Day** held on Norwood Oval on Friday 3rd May (Week 1). This will involve students competing in various Tabloid Events and activities, focusing on maximum participation and enjoyment.
