Privacy and safety in connected environments

At the start of Term 4, Year 1 students will explore what the internet really is and what it means to be online. We will examine the risks of being online and identify ways to protect ourselves and others. Students will continue developing their understanding of good digital citizenship, initially focusing on protecting personal data and identifying trusted networks. Later, we will explore how to safeguard personal information through the use of usernames, passwords, and avatars.

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Performing Arts with Anna

This term we will be concentrating on dance to create a piece for the End of Year Concert.

Students will show their performance skills on Monday Week 9 to the Norwood Community.

Students will be able to:

- experiment with ways to move safely in dance with others
- use the elements of dance to make movements for peers to follow
- use fundamental movement skills in their dance
- create dance movements incorporating a dance prop
- share dance sequences in an informal setting.
- consider alternatives and explore different or creative ways to approach a task or problem.

Physical Education with Joe

The Health and Physical Education program delivers 1 lesson a week for each Year 1 class.

In term 4 the HPE program will continue to work on developing fundamental movement skills (FMS) and object control in particular with a major focus on striking and fielding activities whilst learning to positively interact with others while working in small groups.

Year 1 students will also be participating in our whole school **Redlegathon** 'fun run' which will be held on Norwood Oval on Friday of Week 1 (18th October). This is our school fundraiser event where students will be seeking sponsorship from parents, relatives and friends to walk / run as many laps around the oval in 1 hour.
