Privacy and safety in connected environments

Year 2 students will begin the term by learning about the internet and what it means to be online. We will identify potential risks and explore ways to protect ourselves and others when interacting and sharing media and data online. Students will continue to develop their understanding of good digital citizenship, with an initial focus on safeguarding personal data and identifying trusted networks. Later, we will discover how to protect personal information through the use of usernames, passwords, and avatars.

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Physical Education with Joe

The Health and Physical Education program delivers 2 lessons a week for each Year 2 class.

In term 4 the HPE program will continue to work on fundamental movement skills (FMS) and object control in particular with a major focus on striking and fielding activities. In Health, students will be describing physical changes that occur as they get older and how we celebrate changes.

Year 2 students will also be participating in our **Redlegathon** 'fun run' which will be held on Norwood Oval on Friday of Week 1 (18th October). This is our school fundraiser event where students will aim to walk / run as many laps around the oval in 1 hour. Parents are welcome to attend.

We will begin this term with a unit on **il corpo** (the body) and end the year with **Natale** (Christmas). The Year 2 classes will also be preparing a Christmas song for the End of Year Concert.

Students will:

-respond to stories, games and songs with actions and language
-recognise and use modelled grammatical structures and context related vocabulary of the body and Christmas
-recognise and reproduce the sounds and rhythms of Italian, and experiment with them in writing.
-participate in intercultural experiences related to the celebration of Christmas eg St Nicholas, sing songs, eat panettone and notice and share connections to their own experiences.

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Performing Arts with Anna

This term we will be concentrating on creating a **dance** for the End of Year Concert. Students will show their performance skills on **Monday Week 9** to the Norwood Community. This is a wonderful learning opportunity for students to watch, perform and celebrate their hard work this year.

Students will be able to:

- create their own movements in response to music, images, or stories
- collaborate with peers to choreograph a sequence of movements
- experiment with ways to move safely with others
